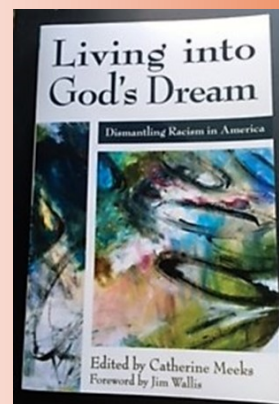




## *The Diocesan Commission on the Racial Reconciliation of All God's Children and Trinity Episcopal Church, Covington*
