

Bishop Hosea Education Fund
Established by the Episcopal Church Women
Of the Diocese of Lexington in October, 1985

Purpose: The purpose of this fund shall be to honor the memory and perpetuate the learning attitude of Addison Hosea, Fourth Bishop of the Diocese of Lexington by providing grants which will enable individuals in the Diocese to pursue educational endeavors.

Statement of Policy

- I. Applicant priorities shall be considered as follows:
 - A. Episcopal Church Women in the Diocese of Lexington
 1. Returning to the work force
 2. Continuing education needs to include seminars, workshops, training of special skills
 3. Clergy and other laity
 4. Those people who have not received Hosea Scholarships
- II. All applications shall be received by May 1 of a calendar year.
- III. Applications shall be filled out completely and include letters of recommendation, brochures or materials of explanation and description on the proposed program for the grant money to be used.
- IV. The ECW Executive Committee will meet to review applications in order to answer requests as soon as possible
- V. All information will be confidential, including names of recipients.
- VI. All monies will be sent directly to the institution or sponsoring organization involved in the recipient's name.
- VII. Accountability: Recipients will be asked to file a brief report to the Episcopal Church Women before May 1 of the following year following the award of the scholarship.
